## Lina 03 Large Triangle Wallmount Installation Instructions

### SAFETY

**BE SURE THE ELECTRICITY TO THE WIRES YOU ARE WORKING ON IS SHUT OFF; EITHER THE FUSE IS REMOVED OR THE CIRCUIT BREAKER IS TURNED OFF. TURNING THE POWER OFF USING THE LIGHT SWITCH IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT ELECTRICAL SHOCK.**

**WARNING! – TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR PERSONAL INJURY:**

**Turn off/unplug lamp and allow to cool before replacing bulb.**

**Do not look directly at lighted bulb.**

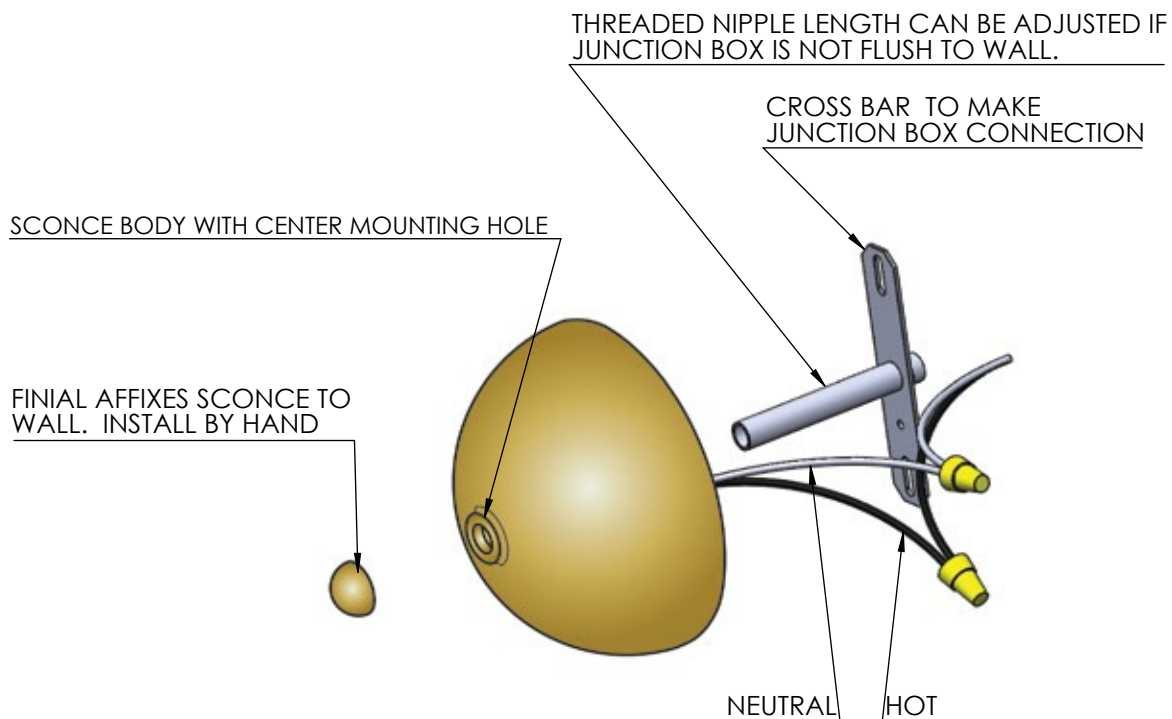
**Keep materials that burn easily away from lighted bulb.**

## INSTALLATION

- 1) Ensure power is disconnected before beginning
- 2) Secure crossbar with threaded nipple to crossbar with screws
- 3) Before wiring, place sconce or flushmount onto threaded nipple. If the thread passing through the mounting hole is too short or long, adjust the length of the nipple at the crossbar.
- 4) Connect the NEUTRAL (white) fixture wire to the NEUTRAL (white) wire of the supply circuit and secure.
- 5) Connect the HOT (black) fixture wire to the HOT (black) wire of the supply circuit and secure.
- 6) Place wiring back into the junction box.
- 7) Slide the sconce or flushmount over the threaded nipple and secure fixture with half round finial by hand till fixture is secure.



## CLEANING

Use only soft cloth to dust and clean fixture. Never use chemicals or abrasive cleaners as it may damage glass.
