Laurel 01 Wallmount Installation Instructions

SAFETY

BE SURE THE ELECTRICITY TO THE WIRES YOU ARE WORKING ON IS SHUT OFF; EITHER THE FUSE IS REMOVED OR THE CIRCUIT BREAKER IS TURNED OFF. TURNING THE POWER OFF USING THE LIGHT SWITCH IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT ELECTRICAL SHOCK.

WARNING! - TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR PERSONAL INJURY:

Turn off/unplug lamp and allow to cool before replacing bulb.

Do not look directly at lighted bulb.


Keep materials that burn easily away from lighted bulb.

INSTALLATION

- 1) Ensure power is disconnected before beginning
- 2) Locate set screw on the underside of the armback, between the back of the leaf and the backplate. Release set screw and remove crossbar. Notice how the wires run though the crossbar.
- 3) When properly installed the set screw will be captured in the crossbar's groove. If the junctionbox is not flush to the wall, adjust the nipple on the crossbar so that the groove is in the correct position to be captured by the set screw. Affix crossbar assembly with provided screws.
- 4) Connect the NEUTRAL (white) fixture wire to the NEUTRAL (white) wire of the supply circuit and secure.
- 5) Connect the HOT (black) fixture wire to the HOT (black) wire of the supply circuit and secure.
- 6) Place wiring back into the junction box.
- 7) Slide the sconce onto the crossbar. Allign the fixture vertically and tighten the set screw to firmly lock in position. If the fixture's backplate is not flush to the wall, remove sconce and ajust the position of the nipple on the crossbar.



CLEANING

Use only soft cloth to dust and clean fixture. Never use chemicals or abrasive cleaners as it may damage glass.
